This notification letter shall become part of the Request for Qualifications for the above referenced project.

1Q. Unifier – does the firm have to purchase the software or can we have access through the City’s web base?

1A. No, you will not have to purchase the program. It will all be done through the City of Phoenix.

2Q. Historically, how often do these emergencies come up? Once a week?

2A. It all depends on the emergency. It could be one or two times within a week, or it could go a couple of weeks to a month without having an emergency.

3Q. Is the pipeline inspection with video inspection capabilities also to be deployed within 1 ½ hours?

3A. Yes, if we needed a CCTV then we would need someone out there within the 1 ½ hours.

4Q. Do the emergency repairs strictly go for the gravity sewer collection system, or should we also anticipate that there will be some repairs or emergency repairs for lift stations, force mains, or even like a discharge manhole situation?

4A. It would include the whole infrastructure for the wastewater collection system for the City of Phoenix.

5Q. We have used Unifier for previous projects, and we know from our experience we’ve noticed there’s a lot of management that comes with uploading forms, downloading forms and tracking all the work that’s associated with the project. Do you have an idea of how much effort we should be considering since it’s new to the City and we as consultants will be trained on how you want us to use it going forward?

5A. Not currently as this is new and what we have learned so far regarding Unifier, the consultant will be trained on how to use the system.

6Q. Can we combine the questions in the RFQ as some are giving the same answers?

6A. Please follow the directions in the RFQ.
