#### **Response to Questions:**

- Q1. Do you have the schedule requirements or constraints for the project?
- A1. No. Due to the size, we are not placing a time constraint on the effort. We believe the establishment of the self-evaluation schedule, remediation timetable, and maintenance plans to be part of the project.
- Q2. What is the anticipation of how many budget years this will have?
- A2. The total number of years this project is expected to last will be a metric we will expect the awarded firm to outline. The Transition Plan will embody the living document idea and extend out better than a decade.
