Project Description

- Provide support related to Toxicity Identification Evaluation (TIE) and Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing (WET) for the following facilities, but not limited to;
 - 91st Avenue Wastewater Treatment Plant
 - 23rd Avenue Wastewater Treatment Plant
 - Cave Creek Water Reclamation Plant
 - Rio Salado Habitat Restoration Area
- Provide assistance and support to meet and stay in compliance with NPDES/AZPDES permits
 - Contract duration five (5) years



Scope of Work

The scope of work for this project may include, but not limited to:

- Update of the City's current TIE/TRE work plans;
- Provide consultation related to WET test results;
- Provide support in the implementation of accelerated testing procedure as required;
- Provide possible lab services to conduct WET/TIE testing through an accredited laboratory;
- Perform toxicity identification and investigate the source of the toxicity;
- Investigate potential control methods;
- Provide written reports of all investigations, findings and recommendations;
- Presentation of all investigations, findings and recommendations
- Perform process and regulatory impact analysis of changes of facility and operation.

Statement of Qualifications Submittal (Cont.)

- Information Sheet (firm name, address, phone, contact info, email, signature of contact person, vendor number, project title & number). Firm logo is optional. Category code not required on the Information Sheet. Do not include any additional information.
- MAXIMUM pages permitted is: <u>12 pages</u>



Statement of Qualifications Submittal (cont.)

Each page with criteria information will be counted.

- Pages that have photos, charts, and graphs will be counted toward maximum number of pages.
- Information Sheet, front and back covers, Table of Contents and tab dividers will NOT be counted toward the maximum page limit, UNLESS they include information that may be considered by the selection panel.
