

ADDENDUM NO. 1

CHANGES

- A. Section 3, Scope of Work, Subsection 3.9, Treatment, Storage, and Disposal Facilities (TDSFs) is amended by adding the following:

If the Contractor is notified that the Treatment, Storage, and Disposal Facility (TSDF) cannot accept the waste in timely manner, alternate arrangements can be made to provide a holding area at a City facility. Hazardous wastes generated at a facility, that facility will hold the waste pending analysis and profiling. In the less common case of a hazardous waste or potential hazardous waste abandoned in an alley or Right of Way (ROW), the Contractor will be expected to provide a holding area for the material until the waste is disposed of.

- B. Once a vendor receives or generates a profile for a disposal event, the vendor is expected to maintain that profile for future disposal events.

- C. The Price Proposal has been revised to include a list of waste material codes, adjusted quantities, and adjusted items. Remove and replace with the revised Price Proposal titled "Pricing Proposal – Revised 5.7.2024".

CLARIFICATIONS

As stated in the RFP document, Section 3, Subsection 3.8, bio-hazardous materials (such as: blood, blood components, body fluids, sharps, medical waste, etc.) disposal services are not included in this contract, but Contractors, under this contract, will provide disposal services of waste that may include human waste, such as sewage.

No.	Question	Answer
1.	In reviewing the HAZARDOUS AND NON-HAZARDOUS MATERIAL REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES RFP I notice that our facility here in Phoenix was not listed as one of the approved facilities. It's my understanding that we were an approved facility in the past. Is there a detailed full approved disposal facility list for the City of Phoenix? Here are the facility details Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. 5736 W. Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85043 USEPA ID#: AZ0000337360	The process of approving facilities is outside the scope of this RFP. If selected for award, the City can provide guidance regarding this subject. The current list is included in the RFP document, 3. Scope of Work, Subsection 3.9, page 23.

2.	What companies are currently contracted for this service?	Current contractors are: - Environmental Response, Inc. - Kary Environmental Services, Inc.
3.	What is the annual utilization of the Hazardous waste services? How many calls per year? Annual spend?	The current contracts expenditure is approximately \$4.9M. The contracts serve many City departments and contract(s) are not set up in a manner to track phone calls. However, the number of purchase orders issued is approximately 1,500 since September 2019.
4.	Pricing on current contract?	In the existing contracts, pricing was not established in the same manner as they are being established under this RFP. The prices were determined by the contractors based off current market value.
5.	It appears that this RFP is to include straight time rates for all call outs with surcharges for afterhours call outs and call outs on weekends. Can we please confirm that this is the format ? On the Pricing proposal just underneath the Group 1 labor rates it says "Emergency rates will apply during the emergency condition and non-emergency (routine) rates shall be applied in routine situations."	See RFP document, Section 3. Scope of Work, paragraph 3.6 Emergency Response. The emergency response fee is an additional flat fee to be charged when directed to respond by the City. This fee is in addition to the labor rates and material/equipment rates required to provide the services.
6.	On responses where hazardous wastes have been created, does the city have holding areas for analysis and profiling where applicable or is it the contractors responsibility to provide a holding solutions for the wastes ?	Refer to the "CHANGES" Section, paragraph A of this addendum, page 1.
7.	Does the City of Phoenix have standing profiles for known and frequent waste streams, if so are they managed by the City or are they managed by the contractor?	Refer to the "CHANGES" Section, paragraph B of this addendum, page 1. The City does have standing profiles that can be provided upon request, if selected for award of a Contract.
8.	Can you please clarify line item 68 and 69 on the pricing proposal? they appear to be specific containers, are these pre-built lab pack materials ? if so what do they include ?	Items 55 (previously 68) and 56 (previously 69) in Group 3 of the Pricing Proposal are for mercury-containing materials that can be in either a lab pack or loose pack. The mercuric materials may be incinerated or sent to the TSDf that accepts mercury-containing waste.
9.	Do we have any further specifics regarding what the constituents are in these streams/potential streams or at least an idea of associated RCRA Codes? The information in the spreadsheet is vague and I am concerned with providing prices without firm constituent details as cost is normally based on RCRA Codes associated and an approval code provide by the TSDf. These can vary widely especially with the lab packs and other items for incineration.	Refer to the "CHANGES" Section, paragraph C, page 1, and the revised Price Proposal document titled "Pricing Proposal – Revised 5.7.2024".

10.	Section 2.16 States offerors must be certified and lists required licenses. If a Arizona Registrar of Contractors – Licensed Contractor (but we are a CA licensed contractor) and an ADEQ Underground Storage Tank Service Provider are not held by the offeror, do we still qualify?	Offerors will need both licenses listed in this question to qualify.
