1.	Item 10 refers to all other Fast Dry acrylic waterborne paint. Specific colors will be needed to give a proper unit price.	The department is seeking to create a product category line for this item, we would require quotes for the other colors not spelled out. Pricing: List less discount.
2.	<p>Section 3 Scope of work 3.1.</p> <p>VEHICLE: The non-volatile portion for all types shall be composed of a 100% acrylic polymer as determined by infrared spectral analysis. The acrylic resin used for <b>Type III</b> shall be a 100% cross-linking acrylic as evidenced by infrared peaks at wavelengths 1568, 1624, and 1672 cm-1 with intensities equal to those produced by an acrylic resin known to be 100% cross-linking.</p> <p><b>I:</b> The Pricing Proposal calls for Fast Dry acrylic waterborne, which is more commonly known as Type II paint. Type III paint is a High Build product and requires HD-21A resin.</p> <p><b>II:</b> We'll need clarification if the City of Phoenix requires Type II Fast Dry or Type III High Build.</p>	Section 3 3. – The department is requesting Type II Fast Dry Acrylic Waterborne Paint. They do not want the High Build.

3.	I am having a little issue with the City of Phoenix and the business license, they are telling me they do not have a general license and they do not have one that covers our products.	Section 2 of the solicitation Instructions, include a subsection, 2.11 Licenses. Offeror must possess all valid certifications and/or licenses. A business licenses with the City of Phoenix is not mentioned nor required.
