1.	I'm reaching out to you on behalf of Safety-Kleen/Clean Harbors and writing to show interest in the below opportunity. However, we would like to check if it is possible to have a list of unknown materials, liquids and solid both. It would help us while preparing the pricing.	Our fluid spills typically consist of hydraulic oil, engine oil, transmission oil, coolant, diesel, and any fluid you find on a garbage truck to make it operate. We occasionally get paint spills from containers loaded with household paint that leak from our tailgates. This is not all-inclusive, but it probably makes up 99% of our spills.
2.	The Bid has contradictory info on how awards will be made. Please clarify which is correct. 2.11 Award of Contract and 2.17 Contract Award	This will be a multiple award solicitation. The City will use a variety of metrics to award these contracts. Responsiveness to the bid, responsible offers, established in service and ability to perform will all be considered when evaluating the bids, but the lowest reasonable and responsive offer (combined totals of the labor, equipment and disposal charges) is how the City will measure and compare each bidder to the others.
