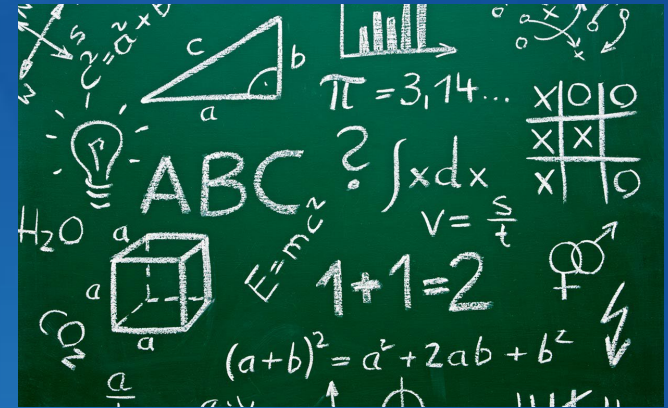

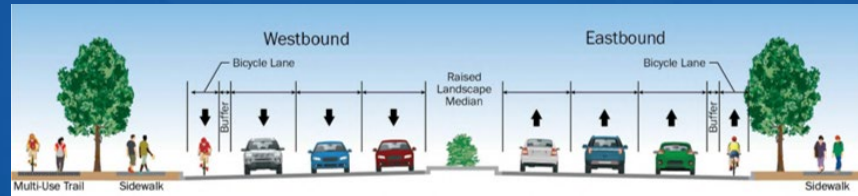

PROJECT LOCATION / SCOPE

HAPPY VALLEY ROAD: 67TH AVENUE TO 35TH AVENUE





SCOPE OF WORK

- The City of Phoenix is proposing to improve Happy Valley Road (HVR) between 67th Avenue and 35th Avenue
- This is a federal aid funding + State & Local match project
- The intent of this project is to widen HVR, improve the signalized intersections including a fiber optic interconnect, and connect the community with sidewalks and multi-use paths that meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requirements.



SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work based on the design plans and specifications will include but not be limited to:

- Mill and overlay of existing pavement or new pavement for some of the project.
- Removal of existing sidewalks, curbs and gutters, and curb ramps
- Construction of new sidewalks, multi-use paths, curbs and gutters, and curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements
- Drainage improvements including a concrete channel
- Fiber optic installation
- Adjustment of existing utilities as described in bid items and specs
- Crack seal and microseal, along with all miscellaneous work included in the bid items and specs to complete the project
- Signing and Striping will be performed by City of Phoenix



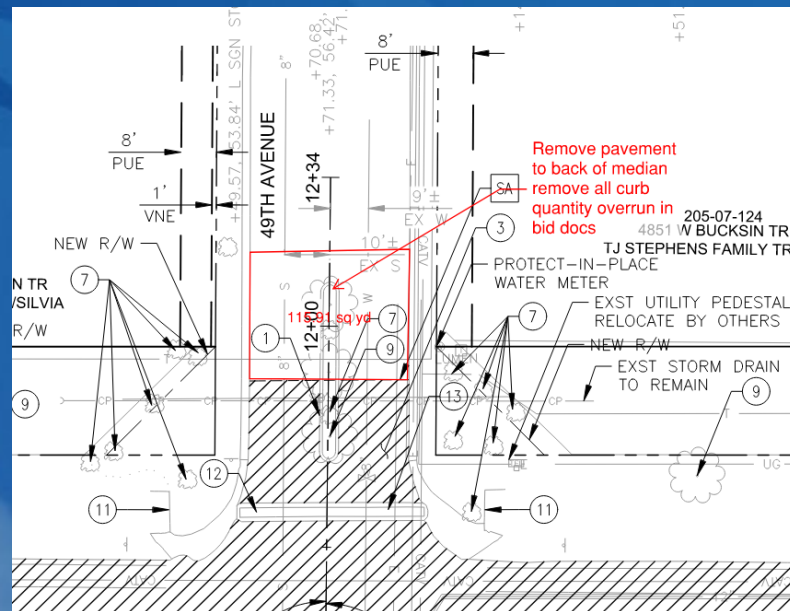
SCOPE OF WORK

- The project will be constructed within existing City of Phoenix ROW and Easements
- The Contractor will provide traffic control and other ancillary items
- Federal Aid Project requires compliance with Environmental Mitigation Measures, including but not limited to:
 - Coordination with the archaeological monitor provided by the City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department
 - Posting of Migratory Bird Treaty Act at the construction site, at all times during construction
- Buy America Certificate:
 - For Procurement of Steel, Iron, or Manufactured Products
- Work to be completed within 660 Calendar Days from NTP

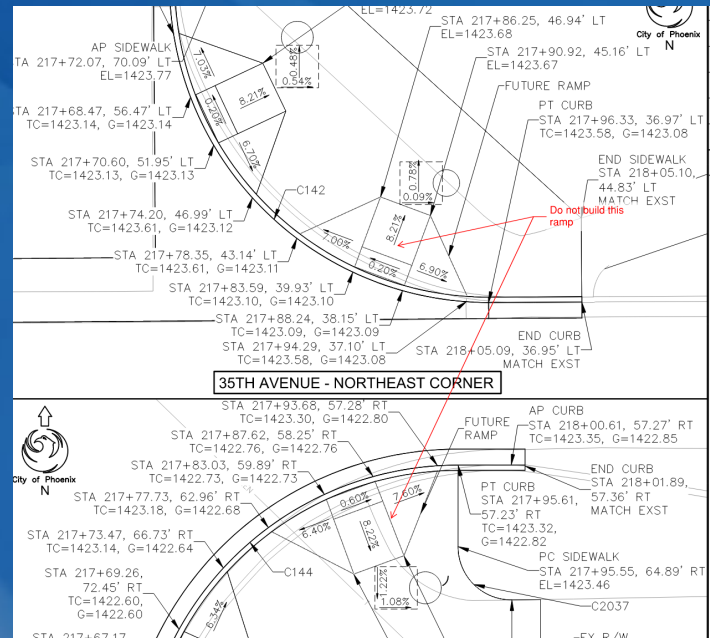
- Remove Pavement increases by 116 SY due to change at 49th Avenue
- Remove Curb increases by 50LF





SCOPE OF WORK

- No Quantity Change but do not build the east leg ramps at 35th Avenue





SCOPE OF WORK

- BID ITEM CHANGES IN UPCOMING ADDENDUM
- Add Mobilization bid item
- Add Miscellaneous Removals
- Republish Bid Item List pages P1 – P10 to avoid bid items cut off.

- Federal Approved Blanket Certification for Econolite Advanced Traffic Controller on August 30, 2024

IMPLEMENTATION

- Projects where new and/or updated advanced transportation controllers is being furnished shall specify:
 - a. Econolite Cobalt Shelfmount Controller and other related models and future model revisions.
 - b. Econolite Cobalt Shelfmount ATC Controller and other related models and future model revisions.
 - c. Econolite Cobalt ASC/3 Firmware and other related versions and future revisions.
 - d. Econolite Cobalt EOS Firmware and other related versions and future revisions.



SCOPE OF WORK

- Channel Excavation –2 borings from the basin and obtaining seismic refraction lines
- USACE 404 Permit – Nationwide Permit #14
- Materials Testing (City or Contractor) - As specified in MAG Section 106.2, The City will pay for the initial or normal test required by the Engineer to guard against unsuitable materials or defective workmanship. The City will provide technicians to perform sampling and testing for quality acceptance. The Contractor may provide its own technicians to quality control of its operations and materials, at no additional cost to the City. Additionally, the Contractor shall perform Quality Control functions where required by the applicable specification sections.
- Percentage of lime – Mix design to be submitted by contractor per MAG. 5% minimum



SCOPE OF WORK

SECTION 103: EARLY PROCUREMENT OF LONG LEAD MATERIALS

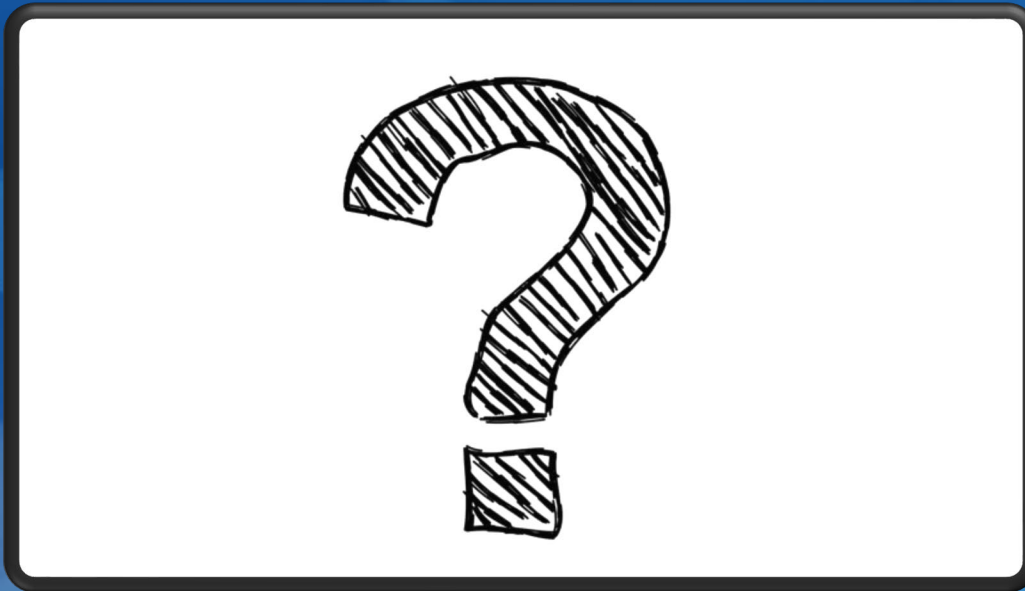
Within 30 days of contract execution and prior to scheduling of a Pre-construction conference meeting, the Contractor may request early procurement of long lead materials. The Contractor's request shall be accompanied by comprehensive justification documents for review; this will include but is not limited to letters from material manufacturers or suppliers, and a project schedule showing the impact and incorporation of long lead items into the project to support the early procurement request. The request shall also outline the expected commencement of construction. The Engineer will evaluate the Contractor's early procurement request and practicable start of construction. Upon review of the request, the Engineer may issue a Notice of Intent or Limited Notice to Proceed based on the agreed upon date in the schedule. After approval of applicable material submittals, the Contractor can then choose to proceed and order long lead item materials. Failure to submit this request after execution of the contract may result in denying requests for additional time for procurement or supply chain concerns. No additional compensation or adjustment in unit prices will be considered as a result of the Contractor's request.

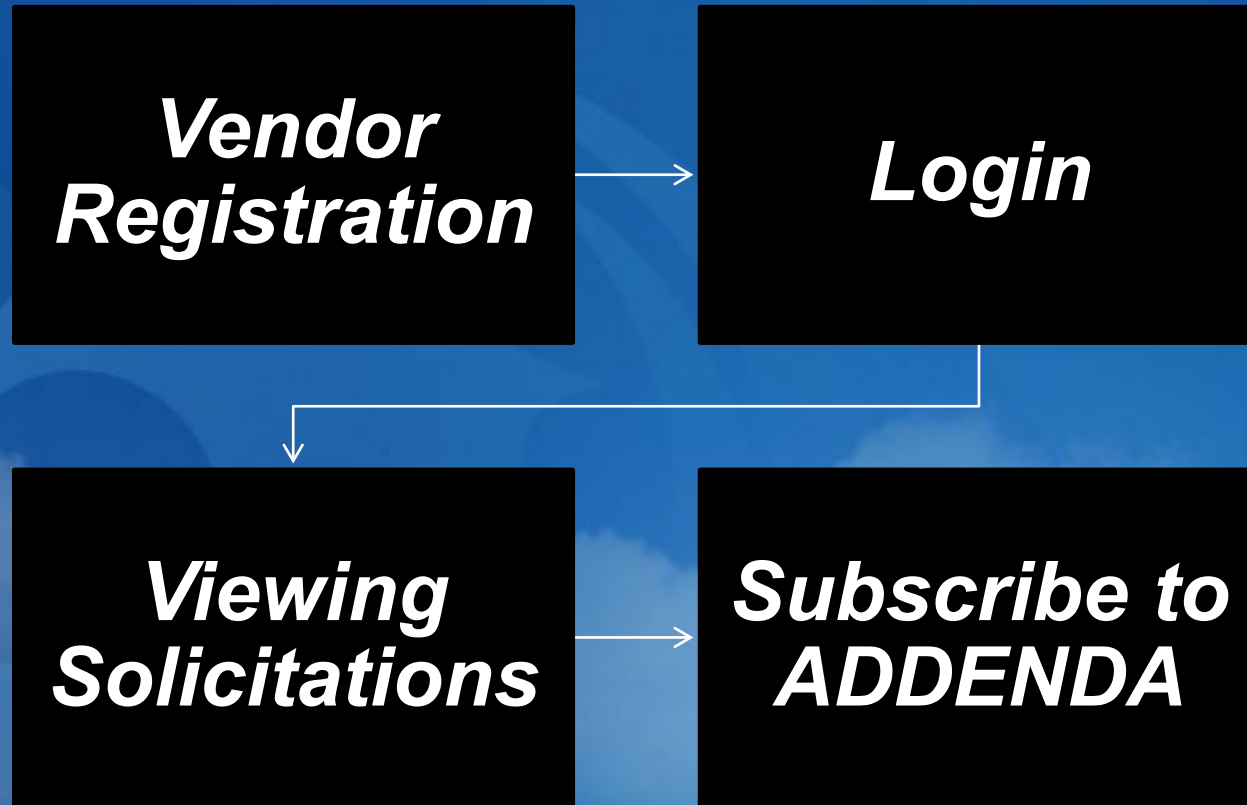
