1.	<p>The pricing section has “Slot Drain Jetting Labor and Equipment”. The current contract has a line for Jetting hourly and one for Jetting per linear foot. There are sites where it is required for the lines on oil water separators need to be jetted. Also, the Glenrosa Sign Shop has a 400’ pipe that has been jetted. This is not the same as slot drain jetting. Please advise.</p>	<p>See Changes #1 and #2 below.</p>
2.	<p>Regarding item 3.5 A. The City liquid wastes shall not be transported in the same truck with liquid wastes from other facilities. Non-City liquid wastes are not allowed to be co-mingled in the same load. In addition, liquid wastes from one City department shall not be co-mingled with wastes from another department. All vehicles to be used for conducting service at the City’s location must be clean prior to arriving on site.</p> <p>In the first line, does other facilities mean facilities from entities other than the City of Phoenix or does this mean, if we pick up from more than one of your facilities, the liquid wastes cannot be comingled and we will need to dispose of the waste, clean the truck, and then go on to the other City of Phoenix facility?</p> <p>In sentence three it states wastes cannot be co-mingled with wastes from another City department. Can wastes that are ordered to be picked up by the same department, but at different City facilities be co-mingled?</p>	<p>See Change #3 below.</p>

1. Section 3, Scope of Work, Subsection 3.3, Contractor Duties, Sub-Section A. INTERCEPTORS, OIL WATER SEPERATORS (OWS), SUMPS AND OTHER DRAINAGE SYSTEMS, Paragraph. 1, last sentence amended to include Hydro Jetting and will read:
“These services shall include labor and equipment and be billed as Grease Trap Pumping, Oil Water Separator Pumping, Septic Pumping, Slot Drain Jetting and Hydro Jetting, in accordance with the Pricing Proposal submittal.”
2. Attachment E. IFB-25-0514 Pricing Proposal is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment E. Amended Pricing Proposal which adds a line on both tabs for Hourly Hydro Jetting Labor and Equipment.
3. Section 3, Scope of Work, Subsection 3.5 Waste Disposal and Storage at Contractor Facility, Paragraph A. last sentence amended to clarify and will read:
“All vehicles to be used for conducting service at the City’s location must be clean prior to arriving on-site and between city locations to provide easy identification of contaminated locations.”
