# Scope of Work / Services



- Services will include design and possible construction administration and observation.
- Fire Station No. 7 is proposed with approximately 18,000 gross square feet.
- A two stories solution may be required.
- It will have 4 apparatus bays and minimum 16 dorms, along with the typical spaces associated with a Fire Station of this size – kitchen, dining, day room, individual restrooms, and exercise space.
- A meeting room for staff and public use may become part of the scope.
- The scope of work will also include site development, parking, hardscape, landscape, irrigation, security lighting and other elements as required.
- The architectural design intent is for a fire station that blends in with the surrounding community.

# Scope of Work / Services



- Other scope of work that may be required is minimal Right of Way improvements, utility extensions, street lighting, added traffic control signal/device at the fire station response apron and other work as needed for a complete project.
- The fire station will be designed in accordance with the Phoenix Fire Department Station A/E Guide and will also comply with City of Phoenix Building Standards. The project shall incorporate previously utilized methodologies, including but not limited to: ICF, SIPS, Recycled Product Content, SEER, EER, and the USGBC V4.1 New Construction Reference Guide.
- It is anticipated that this project will be implemented through a Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) contract.

# **SOQ Evaluation Criteria**

### Maximum number of Points is 400

- A. Design Experience of the Prime Firm (max. 80 Points)
- B. Construction Administration and Observation Experience of Prime Firm (max. 40 Points)
- C. Design Experience of the Key Personnel and Subconsultants (max. 75 points)
- D. Construction Administration and Observation Experience of Key Personnel and Subconsultants (max. 40 points)
- E. Project Understanding and Approach (max. 135 points)
- F. Staffing Information for Key Personnel (max. 30 points)

\*Reference Checks (max. 21 Points) \*Interviews (max. 600 Points)

# Submittal Requirements

#### New Electronic Submittal Process:

Firms interested in this project must submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) electronically to <u>debra.russell@phoenix.gov</u>

- Submit One (1) page Information Sheet that includes project title, project number, RFx number, legal firm name, address, phone number, vendor number, and the name, title, email address and signature of your contact person for the project. Do not include any additional information.
- Paper Size shall be 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> "x11"; Font size no less than 10 pt.
- Each page containing resumes, evaluation criteria, and additional content will be counted toward the maximum page limit
- Pages that have project photos, charts and / or graphs will be counted toward the maximum page limit

MAXIMUM pages permitted is 15 pages: The following will <u>NOT</u> be counted in the max page count: •Front and back covers •Information Sheet •Table of Contents

#### Grounds for disqualification:

- Failure to submit SOQ via email to CS by due date and time
- Submitting SOQ to CS for a different project
- Violating "Contact with City Employees" policy

### **Selection Process**

Each SOQ will be evaluated according to the evaluation criteria in the RFQ.

At least 3, but not more than 5 firms will move forward to <u>interview</u>

One firm will be selected

A contract will be executed upon completion of negotiations of contract terms and City Council approval.






