
PROJECT NO. ST89360040 ADOT CCTV & ARID CITYWIDE EXPANSION

The City of Phoenix is implementing an expansion of its Advanced Transportation Management Program (ATMP) to enhance citywide traffic monitoring and active traffic management capabilities.

This project involves the procurement and installation of 40 Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras and 100 Anonymous Re-Identification Devices (ARID) at traffic signal locations across the city.

All installations will leverage existing infrastructure with no ground disturbance required, ensuring compliance with applicable federal, state, and local regulations.

- Various locations will require the replacement of Traffic Signal Pole Risers to achieve the desired viewing high for the cameras.

15 New Traffic Signal Pole Risers.

All CCTV cameras shall be mounted per the manufacturer's recommendation with a CAT5E Cable that runs unspliced directly from the CCTV camera to the ethernet switch located in the traffic signal cabinet.

25 location will go on existing risers, 13 will be installed on new 10-Foot risers, and 2 locations will need new 20-Foot risers.

All existing metro street name signs, luminaires (including luminaire mast arm poles), radios, antennas, or any other existing infrastructure shall be protected in place or removed and replaced in kind, after the installation of the new riser, at no additional cost to the City.

PROJECT NO. ST89360040 ADOT CCTV & ARID CITYWIDE EXPANSION

What is an ARID?

It is an Anonymous Re-Identification Device that goes inside an intersection traffic signal cabinet and uses Bluetooth or wi-fi to collect travel time data for real-time operations management.

100 Anonymous Re-Identification Devices installed at Traffic Signal cabinets strategically throughout the City of Phoenix.

All devices will be powered over their ethernet connections (PoE).

PROJECT NO. ST89360040 ADOT CCTV & ARID CITYWIDE EXPANSION

The ARID devices shall be mounted on a traffic signal structure that is in the general proximity of the traffic signal cabinet, as approved by the Traffic Management Center (TMC), and mounted per the manufacturer's recommendation with CAT5E Cable that runs unspliced (homerun) directly from the ARID device to the ethernet switch located inside the traffic signal cabinet.

The contractor shall route and bundle all cables neatly and install strain relief where required. All cables shall be routed inside the existing traffic signal structures/poles, inside existing underground conduit & pull boxes, and inside the existing traffic signal cabinet.

PROJECT NO. ST89360040 ADOT CCTV & ARID CITYWIDE EXPANSION

System Acceptance Test

All devices and components shall be subject to testing and monitoring to determine conformance with all applicable specifications and to ensure proper operation of the equipment and system.

- The test shall exercise all stand-alone (non-network) and network functional operations of the ARID devices.

- Communication with the City of Phoenix Traffic Management Center via the City's fiber optic/radio network.
- The ARID devices shall be subjected to a subsystem test for 72 consecutive hours.

As part of the <u>System Acceptance Test</u> (SAT), the contractor shall demonstrate that all hardware functions are operational to the City of Phoenix Traffic Management Center through the City's fiber optic cable/radio network.
