CHANGES

Change 1 - Pricing Proposal is hereby deleted and replaced with **Revised** Pricing Proposal.

Change 2 -Section 3.2.1 Trash and Debris Removal shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.2.1 Trash and Debris Removal

Contractor shall clear designated parcels of trash and debris, materials include but are not limited to various amounts of building materials, refuse, rubble, litter, unsound fences, or other materials.


Contractor shall keep the premises clean of all rubbish and debris generated by the work involved, and leave the premises neat and clean. Upon completion of any parcel, sidewalks and streets shall be swept clean as needed to prevent injury to pedestrians. All surplus material, trash, refuse, rubbish, and debris shall be disposed of by the Contractor. The City will reimburse disposal and dump fees without markup, with proper receipts submitted with Contractor's invoices to Ordering Department Representative.


On occasion the City may request to have trash and debris removed from roof tops (i.e. deteriorated evaporative coolers or parts, damaged air conditioners, detached shingles, and/or miscellaneous trash and debris, etc.).

The use of leaf blowers is strictly prohibited pursuant to Maricopa County Ordinance P-25 (<https://www.maricopa.gov/DocumentCenter/View/2015/P-25---Leaf-Blower-Restriction-Ordinance-PDF>). Acceptable alternatives to leaf blowers include brooms, rakes, walk behind leaf vacuums, and PM-10 Compliance Sweepers. Debris shall not be swept into the street. Burying trash, debris, etc. is not permitted.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

No.	Question	Answer
1.	To the best of my knowledge, the City of Phoenix no longer holds a towing contract. As a result, abandoned vehicles reported on properties are not being removed. However, if we, as contractors, engage a towing company that adheres to state regulations, would we be permitted to use their services for vehicle removal?	Towing services are not included in this solicitation. Contractor(s) shall not invoice the City for any towing services and are advised to contact the Ordering Department Representative if the services are found to be needed.
2.	If there has been an increase in the cost of equipment, rental prices, and materials, such as fill dirt, within the first four months of the contract, and we have supporting documentation to verify this, how should we proceed given that the prices submitted in the initial one-year contract are firm and fixed?	Per Section 5.2, pricing is firm and fixed for the first year of the contract.
3.	When submitting the price for constructing a berm per linear foot, should the cost include labor, materials, and rentals, or is it intended to cover labor only?	Berm construction shall include material only, pursuant to the Revised Pricing Proposal posted with this Addendum 2. Labor and Specialized Equipment Rental fees shall be invoiced separately.
4.	In reference to Section 4.4, Cost and Payments, Section G, how can a fixed price be established in the Offer when palm trees vary in size, height, shape, and the amount of dead fronds varies in size? For example, as illustrated in the images below. 	Palm fronds shall not be trimmed higher than 10 feet above the ground. See Section 3.2.8.
5.	In reference to Section G of the 4.4 Cost and Payments, Similar to the palm trees, we have observed that tree sizes and shapes can vary significantly, particularly those in the larger sizes as listed in the pricing proposal. Some trees may feature pricklers that extend up to four inches, while others have branches that overhang structures, even when situated	Group 3 Tree Removal refers to the removal of dead trees. The condition of a tree, or presence of "prickers" has no bearing. See Section 3.2.8. Tree trimming shall be calculated based on number of labor hours only. Per Section 3.2.1., the City will reimburse

<p>more than 10 feet away, requiring specialized equipment for proper handling. Additionally, certain trees may have more branches or an increased quantity of dead leaves, which does not appear to be accounted for in the current pricing proposal.
