Scope of Work

### **Residential Services :**

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Residential cleaning and maintenance services shall be provided for the entire area of each Residence, including rights-of-way, alleys, and easements. Contractor shall visit each Residence during the month from assigned locations. All Residences are vacant single-family units. Contractor shall complete all cleaning and maintenance services, including, but are not limited to, vegetation control, trash pickup, removal of illegal dumping, rock narrowing, fence repairs and installation, tree maintenance and removal, curb and easement maintenance, sign repairs and installation, property inspections, pest control, and other related services associated with property maintenance.
