

## ADDENDUM No. 1

## CHANGES

Change 1 - Section 5, Special Terms and Conditions, Subsection 5.3, Price is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

5.3 Price

All prices submitted shall be firm and fixed for the initial year of the contract. Thereafter, price increases will be considered annually provided the adjustments are submitted in writing with 60 days' notice to the Procurement Officer. Price increase requests shall be accompanied with written documentation to support the increase, such as a letter from the manufacturer, published price index, applicable change in law, etc. Price decrease requests do not require supporting documentation and are allowed at any time during the contract term.

The City will be the sole judge in determining the allowable increase amount. Price increases agreed to by any staff other than the Chief Procurement Officer are invalid. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees to repay all monies paid because of a requested price increase unless the increase was specifically approved, in writing, by the Chief Procurement Officer.

Change 2 - Section 3. Scope of Work, 3.2.4 Section Housing, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

D. Provide a Shurlock boss in the top and bottom openings having 72 clean, sharp teeth that provide full engagement, angled at 90 degrees, and having a depth of 5/64".

E. Provide two indentations in the top and bottom opening designed to receive a Shurlock ring to provide positive positioning of the head when mounted from a mast arm or span wire hanger.

Change 3 – 'IFB 25-0529 – Submittal - Price Proposal' is hereby deleted in its entirely and replaced with 'Addendum No. 1 - IFB 25-0529 - Submittal – Price Proposal', attached separately to this Addendum.

4.	Is there any federal funding used that will require the materials on the contract to be certified to IIJA or BABA?	No Federal funding will be used during the term of the contract(s).
5.	Are the signal heads (Group 1, items 1-34) to be provided as a complete assembled unit consisting of signal head, led module, backplate and signal mount(plumbizer)? Or are those signals only without led module or signal mounts? We did not see signal mounts listed for some of the items.	Refer to the Addendum No. 1 - IFB 25- 0529 – Submittal – Pricing Proposal, Group 1 – Signal Head Components and Housing for items no. 1 – 34 which require signal mount (plumbizer). Item No. 3 <i>"Type "F1" with Plumbizer 3</i> <i>Section 12" Vehicle Signal Head Mounted on Signal Mast Arm"</i> Signal heads should be completely assembled, consisting of the signal head, led module, backplate and signal mount (plumbizer) as required. The backplate may be installed and shipped with the signal head or can be packaged separately.
6.	The signal section requirements state shurlocks are to be provided. Can you advise how many shurlocks are needed per signal section?	Review Change 2, listed on page 1 of this addendum.
7.	Are signal backplates to have louvers or to be solid? Should the backplates be polycarbonate or aluminum? In the past louvers were provided for some signal heads (Doghouse/Hawk). " <i>The</i> <i>plumbizer for the doghouse style traffic</i> <i>signal heads shall be angled, elevated</i> <i>plumbizer shall be steal or aluminum</i> " Section 3, Scope of Work, Section 3.2, Traffic Signal Heads, Subsection 3.2.10 Mounting Hardware, item C. "Cast the <i>elevator plumbizer from steel or</i> <i>aluminum, resulting in smooth castings,</i> <i>or machine the plumbizer to remove all</i> <i>sharp edges.</i> "
8.	Several of the bidding items say "additional backplate/ background". Can you please advise what this means? Do you need an	Items listed as "additional backplate/background" are extra backplates only.
