| 1. | Who is currently doing your wildlife program? | Loomacres Wildlife Management |
| 2. | From a contract perspective, are you extremely happy with the actual contractor and program? Are you looking to enhance the program? | The Operations Division is very satisfied with the current contractor and program. There is always room for improvements and enhancements. |
| 3. | How long was the last length of contract and did the contractor finish it? | The current contract is for five years and the awarded contractor did not change during the term. |
| 4. | What is the hourly rate of the actual contract in 2021 ? | The Hourly Fee for the current Contract is \$56. |
| 5. | What types of firearms are actually used at the airport (shotgun only or rifle too)? | Long guns, shotguns, and air rifles are used at the airport. |
| 6. | What is the current raptor management program? Are you trapping, marking, banding and/or relocating (if yes, how far)? What are you doing with birds that return? | The current raptor management program includes trapping, marking, and relocating. |
| 7. | Do they have a wildlife survey protocol or standard procedures (or continual monitoring)? | Standard procedures are established by the Contractor. |



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| 8. | How do they collect wildlife data at the moment ? What is the software they are using ? How many hours per day are they collecting data? | Contractor uses paper forms, Excel spreadsheets, and contractor-owned software to collect data. Daily collection of data times varies and is dependent upon survey schedules and daily wildlife activity. Some of the data is collected by Aviation staff and at other times by the Assigned Biologist. |
| 9. | Is rodenticide or pesticide use is part of the contract? | No. |
| 10. | What kind of proof for requirements are you looking for ? Do you need a list of documents (ex. Wildlife Hazard Assessment or training, how do we prove it) ? | If <u>specific</u> documentation isn't requested for a minimum qualification, it's at the Offeror's discretion to select substantiated and legitimate proof (e.g. certificate of course completion, attendance record, business license, copy of report, etc.) showing the Offeror meets the minimum qualification. |
| 11. | Can Contractor give 3 references of canadian airports, of a similar size to Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, or US landfill sites where we provide Wildlife Control Services and similar services? | Offerors must comply with reference requirements as stated in paragraph 6. References, Section VI - Submittals. |
| 12. | Must the primary and the secondary biologist have the same credentials, or can the secondary biologist work underneath a certified and more highly experienced primary? | See paragraphs 8.2 and 8.3 of Section V - Scope of Work. |
